2. commission outstanding authors, scholars, artists, scientists, or musicians to come to ISU to serve as visiting members of the faculty and to deliver lectures to classes and to the academic community.

Requests for support should be submitted by October 3, 2011. The Provost will determine final approval and funding amount. The unit applying for Sage Funds is responsible for making all arrangements for the visit (i.e. working with the Foundation Office on the contract, making travel arrangements, scheduling rooms, marketing).
