- FAQs document was developed and disseminated to give an overview of what open access.
- Three open forums were held (March 20th, 11:00 am 12:30 pm. STV 401, March 26, 3:00 4:30 pm, STV 401 & April 9, 2014, 4:00-5:30 pm COB 366).
- A survey was developed and distributed to the campus community including faculty and graduate students. The survey will close at the end of April
